Storm Reminder: Plan Ahead With Emergency Kit

Late last year, Super Storm Sandy reminded us all of the destruction, hardship and widespread power outages that disasters can cause. Whether it's a major local storm or a massive national emergency, disasters can strike anywhere, any time.

Duquesne Light urges its customers to be prepared for power outages – and other disasters – before they occur by assembling an emergency supply kit. Each kit should contain materials and supplies that you would need to survive a prolonged event. Your kit should be stored in a location that is easy to access even in the dark, and its contents should be checked and updated regularly.



Following is a list of items Duquesne Light and the American Red Cross recommend including in your emergency kit:

- Flashlights
- Extra batteries
- Battery-powered or hand-crank radio (NOAA Weather Radio if possible)
- Battery-powered or wind-up clock
- Portable heater (oil or gas, and be sure to use safely)
- Portable generator (always use outdoors, never inside your home or garage)
- Cell phone and charger
- Bottled water (one gallon per person per day to last three days in an evacuation and two weeks at home)
- Nonperishable food (enough to last three days in an evacuation and two weeks at home)
- Manual can opener, paper plates and plastic utensils
- Multi-purpose tool (such as a Swiss Army Knife)
- First aid kit and prescription medications
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items
- Special needs items for children, elderly and/or disabled family members
- Blankets and/or sleeping bags
- Warm clothes, sturdy shoes and heavy gloves
- Games, activities and reading materials for children and adults
- Pet supplies
- Emergency telephone numbers for family members, police, fire department and Duquesne Light
- Extra cash
- Extra set of keys
- Copies of important documents such as insurance policies, bank account information and identification cards all stored in a portable container

Electric Safety

Electricity is a clean form of energy that helps add convenience, comfort and enjoyment to our everyday lives. However, it is also a very powerful and dangerous force. The human body is an excellent conductor of electricity. For instance, if you touch an overhead power line, which are not insulated, serious injury or death could result. In order to ensure your safety, you should always be cautious when you are near electrical facilities.

Some tips to remember:

- A wire laying on the ground may still be energized. You should not touch the wire and contact Duquesne Light.
- If you hire roofers or tree trimmers who may work within 10 feet of your service drop, they should contact Duquesne Light.
- Never try untangling an object like a kite or shoes from a power line, contact Duquesne light.

Electric safety is not limited to outdoor situations. There are also many dangers inside the home. Here are some key tips to remember when working with and around electricity in the home.

- Never operate an electric appliance while touching a metal object, standing on a wet surface, or taking a bath or shower.
- Never insert metal objects into an appliance or outlet. If there is a problem, contact a professional for repair.
- Avoid using extension cords whenever possible. If you must use one, do not exceed its recommended rating or plug it into another extension cord. And always unplug the extension cord after use.

By following these simple tips, you can be sure of a safe environment for you and your family.

Going Electric Shopping?

If you're interested in shopping for a new electricity supplier and aren't sure where to begin, head to www.papowerswitch.com, a website operated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC). Type in your zip code and the site will give you a list of electric generation suppliers in your area, a comparison of their offers, and much more. You also can reach the PUC at 1-800-692-7380.

The website of the Pennsylvania Office of the Consumer Advocate, www.oca.state.pa.us, is another good source of information. There you will find a free online guide that provides "apples to apples" comparisons for electric generation suppliers in each utility's service area in the state, including Duquesne Light's. You also can call 1-800-684-6560 for information.

The Price to Compare (PTC), measured in cents per kilowatt-hour, is used to compare prices and potential savings among generation suppliers. The PTC, which can be found under the Electric Usage chart on Page 1 of your Duquesne Light bill, tells you how much you are paying for your supply and transmission charges.

All residential customers, including Customer Assistance Program (CAP) participants, are eligible to shop. However, if you are a CAP customer and choose a supplier, you will get two bills – one from your supplier and one from Duquesne Light.
